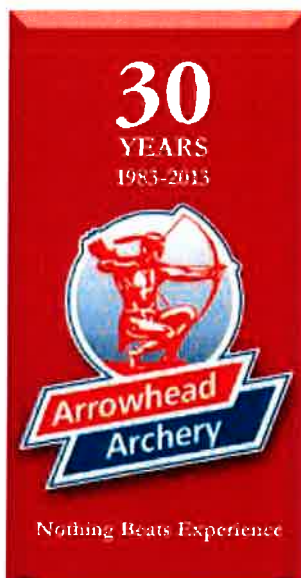

2014 IBO ULTIMATE CHALLENGE SERIES

This year's Series is about to get started with our first round being hosted by Twin Coast Archery Club – this is the last shoot to be held on the Orchard's property in Kaiwaka as they move to a new property very shortly after round one.

Last year saw great participation and the introduction of the new Kerikeri Archery Club for the Nationals. There was good attendance at all shoots and everyone enjoying the unmarked rounds set out by each of the clubs who participated.

This year's dates are:

15 th June	Rnd 1	Twin Coast Archery Club - Kaiwaka
13 th July	Rnd 2	Dargaville Archery Club – Dargaville
10 th August	Rnd 3	Mt Tiger Archery Club – Whangarei
14 th Sept.	Rnd 4	Whitford Forrest Archery Club – Auckland – The Final.

As with past years there are 4 rounds and the series is based over your best 3 rounds giving a Series Winner for each division at the Final in September.

Each round will have its own certificates and presentation being done on the day. Overall points are awarded from 10 down to 1 for each division for the top score downward giving a maximum score of 30 points for the Series.

At the final there are certificates for that round and also the prize giving for the Series of certificates and Trophies for the Series Champions.

As with all events we ask that you pre-register by sending in your entry form and payment prior to the event. Late entry fees will apply as in previous years. All entries should be in on the Wednesday prior to the event.

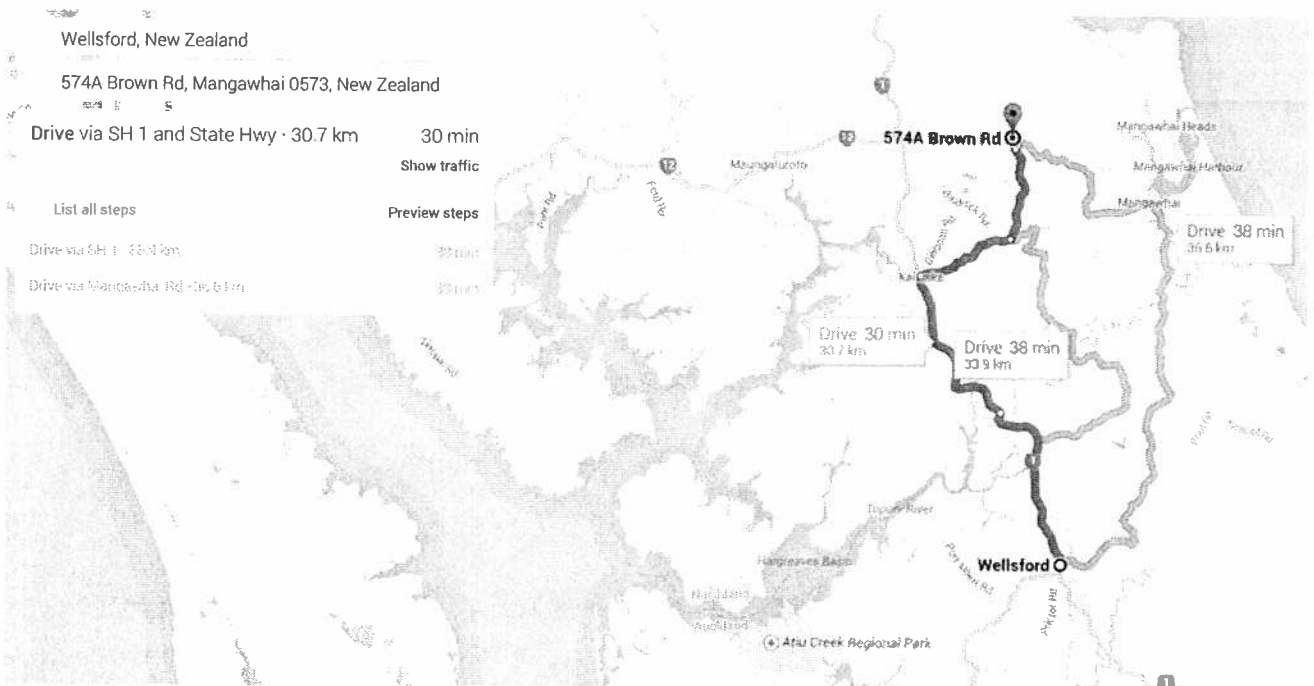

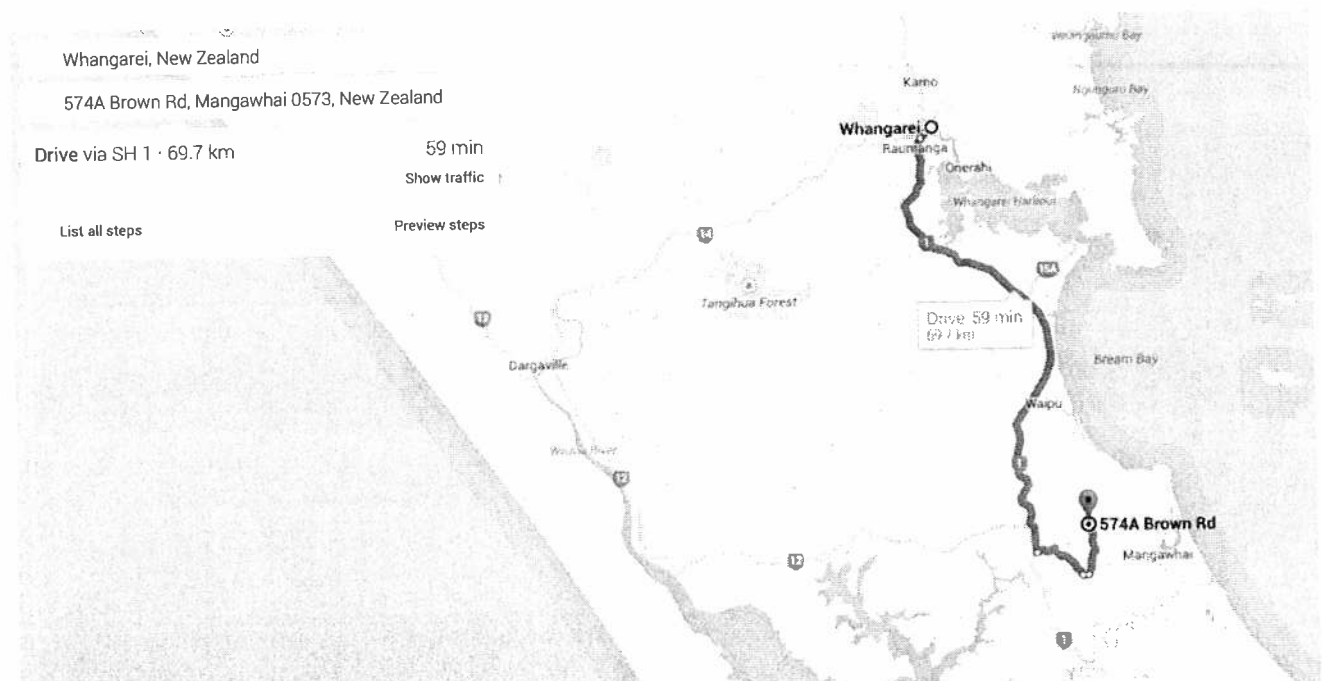
